CISB offers a world-class facility with an internationally recognized Canadian education curriculum and all three of the International Baccalaureate Programmes with a maximum capacity of 1400 students.

## Academic Calendar

The 184 days in the school year are divided into two semesters from August to January and February to June. Classes are 55 minutes long and are rotated over a 10-day cycle.

## Grades

CISB uses the IB's 1 to 4 and 1 to 7 grading scales for the IB Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma programs, respectively. Canadian courses are assessed on a 100% grade scale. An IB grade of at least 3 or Canadian grade of at least 60 is required for credit.

## Graduation Requirements

CISB graduates are required to obtain **20** credits (including compulsory credits) from grade 11 and grade 12 level courses. Students studying the IB Diploma Program are awarded equivalent credits.

These **20** credits must include:

- English Credits
- Mathematics Credits
- A Modern History Credit
- A Science Credit
- English and at least four other subjects must be taken at the grade 12 level
- Successful completion of the English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA)
- Successful completion of Creative, Activity, Service (CAS)
