Agency and Student Leadership in the PYP

To develop student agency, all members of the community believe in and commit to students' capacity to lead. The IB encourages schools to provide leadership opportunities that include influencing and inspiring others, taking initiative, and offering support or service to those in need. Everyone, including students, should feel a sense of contribution to their community. (*The Enhanced PYP*, 2018).

In grade five, students develop their learner profile and skill sets through learning engagements and by volunteering as part of the student leadership program.
