Our University Counselors

IN THE KNOW

CISB has expanded our University and Career Counselling services to help ensure all of our Bobcats reach their post-secondary goals. Our counselors have already helped many graduates to successfully apply to universities and colleges. We interviewed our University counseling office to explain what they do and how we can all work together to help our Bobcats succeed!



The University and Career Counselling office is AKD Education Group support services provided to the Canadian International School which they own and operate. The support services offered, involve Life Skills development providing the students the necessary abilities to explore career occupation options and the required academic program exposures in High School and University or College. The office also provides consulting services in university and program course selection, University application preparation and workshops for students and parents.

When students are doing universities preparation, they may have many questions or misunderstandings. For instance, required components has four areas, including academic performance, essay question, recommendation letter and language proficiency. We suggest that they should prepare those applications in advance. At the same time, we will hold workshops about required of application in different countries. At the end of year, we are going to have alumni that invite graduates to share their successful and interesting experiences at universities.





Nowadays, many parents have a better understanding of university rankings and their expectations, and we can't deny that most parents and students dream of studying at famous universities. As a university counselor, we work with students to help choose universities that complement their interests and reflect the many other aspects involved with such a big life decision. This process is personalized to ensure each student's interests and goals are considered. For example, we had many graduates who have been accepted to the top 50 Art schools in the world. Before they applied to universities, they knew who they want to be and what their interests were and began to develop their portfolios years in advance. For this year's graduates, we are looking forward to working closely with them and their families, to develop their goals, support them and their applications, and to share in their excitement as the university admissions acceptances start rolling in!
