

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The CISB Academic Scholarship program is intended to support gifted high school students (Grade 9-12) who show much academic promise and make contributions to the whole school community and may be in need of financial assistance.

Scholarship decisions will be made by a Scholarship Committee appointed by the school and will be based on academic excellence, as well as social contributions to the whole school community and the global community.

Students who have been awarded the scholarships and bursaries are required to pay for the full school year tuition fees at the start of the school year.

Scholarship scale:

Middle Years Programme

(Entering Grades 9-11)

- Total of 56 marks out of 56 marks: 100% deduction on tuition fees
- Minimum 55 marks out of 56 marks: 50% deduction on tuition fees
- Minimum 53 marks out of 56 marks: 25% deduction on tuition fees
- Minimum 50 marks out of 56 marks: 20% deduction on tuition fees

Diploma Program/New Brunswick Credit Programme

(Entering Grade 12)

- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.65 or higher: 100% deduction on tuition fees
- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.4 or higher: 50% deduction on tuition fees
- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.1 or higher: 25% deduction on tuition fees
- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.8 or higher: 20% deduction on tuition fees

The Deadline for Scholarship applications is June 1st, 2021.

Please note that 2021-2022 school fees are due on July 31st, 2021.
