Month: April


Avg. High 20°C / 68°F

Hotel: Reignwood Country Club (Changping)



Camp is located on a private golf resort property equipped with a four-star hotel. Our dormitories are clean, modern, and are 100% suited for international groups.

Our housing options are to a high-quality standard. Student rooms consist of anywhere from 2-12 person bunk bed style dormitories. All rooms are equipped with ensuite bathrooms and showers.

Chaperone staff are located on each floor for appropriate supervision.

Hallways are monitored with 24/7 security cameras.
