Location: Beijing Month: April

Avg. High 20°C / 68°F

Avg. Low 8°C 46°F

Avg. Rainfall 21 mm

Humidity 46%

Beijing begins to warm up in April. The air is cooler in the evenings yet tolerable for outdoor activities. Rainfall is surely possible, so please bring your ponchos/raincoats! Make sure to wear appropriate clothing as most activities are outdoors.







ACCOMODATION DETAILS

Housing: Tuobang (TB) Campsite 双秀湖营地 - 北京市延庆区-拓邦基地

Camp is located in a mountainous area of Yanqing District, a private piece of property used for teambuilding, camps, and more. Housing is in an individual housing unit.

Students will be 3 students to a room, with private shower and bathroom. Please bring own toiletries and towels.

Chaperone staff are located on each floor for appropriate supervision.

Hallways are monitored with 24/7 security cameras.
