SSAT Examination Introduction

SSAT: Secondary School Admission Test

Purpose of the examination: A requirement to enter private secondary schools in the United States and Canada.

Learning purpose: mainly to improve students' math, English, and reading comprehension abilities, logical thinking, and development potential.



SSAT Level

The SSAT is divided into two levels:

Upper Level (for grades 8–11) and Middle Level (for grades 5-7).



SSAT Middle-level and Upper-level Similarities and Differences

Similarities: The exam form and time are exactly the same.

Differences: There is a difference between the difficulty of the exam and the total score.

The middle-level score range is 1320–2130, and the upper-level score range is 1500–2400.



SSAT Exam Content

The SSAT exam is divided into four sections: vocabulary, reading, mathematics, and writing.

The first three sections are assessed, while the writing section is not scored but will be included along with the official grades sent to the schools. Therefore, it is important to approach the writing section seriously.

SSAT Scoring Criteria

- The score for the SSAT exam is calculated in two steps according to the SSAT scoring criteria:
- Step 1: Raw scores are calculated for each section (vocabulary, reading, and mathematics) based on the number of questions answered correctly, incorrectly, or left unanswered.
- Step 2: The raw scores are then converted into standardized scores. The calculation method for the raw score is as follows: one point is awarded for each correctly answered question, and a quarter point is deducted for each unanswered or skipped question.
