Location: Beijing

Month: Oct

Avg. High 20°C / 68°F

Avg. Low 8°C 46°F

Beijing weather cools down, and prepare for it to be chilly. The air is cooler in the evenings yet tolerable for outdoor activities if properly dressed. Rainfall is less likely, but possible, so please bring your ponchos/raincoats! Make sure to wear appropriate clothing as most activities are outdoors.













ACCOMMODATION



Camp is located on a private golf resort property equipped with a four-star hotel. Our dormitories are clean, modern, and are 100% suited for international groups.

Our housing options are to a high-quality standard. Student rooms consist of anywhere from 8-12 person bunk bed style dormitories. All rooms are equipped with ensuite bathrooms and showers.

Chaperone staff are located on each floor for appropriate supervision.

Hallways are monitored with 24/7 security cameras.







FOOD



Food at camp is served buffet style and satisfies all categories of nutrition. We adhere to the highest of sanitary standards. Food labels are all bilingual.

Student and faculty dietary restrictions are collected prior to camp and our kitchen staff and YMCE facilitators are informed and knowledgeable of every detail.

Can I bring a phone or iPad?

There will be no phones or electronics welcomed on this trip.

Is there time for shopping?

There will be no shopping on this trip. Please keep money and valuables at home. These items are bring at your own risk

What is Gaga?

Is Camp safe?

Expectations: 要求:

- All travelers must have a valid I.D. (grade 5 only)
- 所有的旅行者必须持有效身份证件

- CISB reserves the right to send a student home at the expense of the parent for inappropriate behavior, up until and including the last day of the trip.

Expectations: 要求:

- Students are not permitted to switch rooms or seats on the bus or train.
- 学生不允许换房间,或者在汽车、火车上换座位
- -Students shall be in their rooms by curfew, which will be announced each night. No exceptions will be made unless there is an emergency. Students may not leave their rooms after bed check.
- 学生必须在宵禁前回到自己的房间, 宵禁时间将于每晚公布。除非有紧急情况,否则不得例外。学生在查房后不得离开房间。
- Students must be on time for events and curfew.
- 学生必须准时出席活动以及遵守宵禁时间



Expectations: 要求:

- Wake up/leaving the room in the A.M. /P.M curfew is at the discretion of the chaperones on a daily basis and MUST be followed accordingly.
- 严格遵守由陪同监护人 (教师)确定的起床时间, 离开房间以及宵禁时间



General Rules: 要求:

- No Smart phone devices and laptops for Elementary
- No Cash needed for Elementary
- Students may bring healthy snacks, but this food is not to be shared.



General Rules: 要求:

- Rule of 3: Students may not leave the group (e.g. bathroom break) on their own or alone with an adult, and must have a third person (student or faculty). Child Protection Rule
- Group photo will take before every activity from teachers and will send only at night daily (No individual photo)
- Parent Wechat group for announcements and photos only except emergency.



General Rules: 要求:

Emergency Protocol:

At night, we will have student, faculty and YMCE, and nurse rooms marked on outside. Kids to be trained to know where to go and who to find.

In case of an accident, student will be checked by the onsite nurse and send to the local hospital if need. We will contact parents to get the approval before we go to the local hospital or send to the hospital they appointed.

For sickness in Beijing, student will be checked by the onsite nurse. We will contact parents to get the approval before taking any medicine. If the student cannot attend any activity, he/she will stay with the nurse; we will contact parents to come to pick up or we send one of our admin staff with the school driver to come to escort back.

For sickness outside Beijing, student should stay with the group until the end of the trip if parents cannot come to pick up or admin staff will come to escort the student back if the symptom is serious. Separate room or care may need to be arranged.
