







PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Suzhou program, themed "Exploring the Fusion of Nature and Culture & Team Collaboration," offers a dynamic mix of outdoor adventures, cultural immersion, and team-building activities.

Students hike through Guangfu, surrounded by lakes, mountains, and ancient architecture, fostering physical fitness and an appreciation for the harmony of nature and culture. Outdoor challenges include raft-building, kayaking on Shihu Lake, and the Garden Expo Park Geocaching Adventure, which enhance teamwork, navigation skills, and problem-solving abilities. The F1 Race Car Building challenge further boosts creativity and collaboration.

The program also delves into Suzhou's rich cultural heritage. Students visit the Humble Administrator's Garden, experience a Tea Culture workshop, and explore Xiangshan Bang Architectural Culture, learning ancient carpentry techniques like mortise and tenon joints and crafting Luban Locks.

These activities promote physical development, teamwork, and a deeper understanding of the connection between nature, culture, and traditional craftsmanship, leaving students with unforgettable memories and valuable life lessons.



Visit the Humble Administrator's Garden

Visiting the Humble Administrator's Garden offers students a rare opportunity to immerse themselves in traditional Chinese garden design, an integral part of China's cultural heritage. Famous for its picturesque landscapes, tranquil ponds, and intricate rockeries, the garden embodies the perfect harmony between nature and architecture.

The garden is a living example of how Chinese gardens aim to create a harmonious space that reflects the natural world, offering both beauty and tranquility. Xiangshan Bang Architectural Culture

This activity offers students a chance to explore Suzhou's Xiangshan Bang architectural culture and traditional woodworking techniques. The Xiangshan Bang is a group of skilled carpenters known for their unique wooden structures.

Students will learn about mortise and tenon joints, a technique that interlocks wood without nails, reflecting the precision of ancient Chinese architecture. They will also have the opportunity to create a Luban Lock, an ancient wooden puzzle, to understand its design and enjoy assembling it. Through these hands-on experiences, students will gain a deeper appreciation for traditional craftsmanship, sparking their creativity and enhancing their understanding of the beauty and skill behind ancient woodworking.









Shihu Lake Kayaking

Shihu Lake in Suzhou provides an ideal natural setting for kayaking, offering students the chance to engage with the beauty of nature while developing both physical and teamwork skills.

As students navigate the lake, they will work together, enhancing their collaboration, communication, and decision-making abilities in a real-world setting. The physical challenge of kayaking also promotes coordination, strength, and endurance, contributing to overall fitness. Beyond the physical benefits, the serene surroundings help students relax, offering a break from the pressures of academics and fostering mental well-being. This immersive experience not only strengthens teamwork and physical health but also encourages mindfulness and stress relief, making it a perfect balance of mental and physical growth.








Suzhou Mountain Hiking

Students embark on a half-day hiking trip to Guangfu in Suzhou, rich in content and profound in significance. They walk along ancient bluestone paths, weaving through Ming and Qing dynasty architecture, experiencing the weight of history and the charm of culture. Along the way, students enjoy picturesque views of lakes and mountains, immersing themselves in the tranquility and beauty of the Jiangnan water town. The activity not only strengthens their physical health but also fosters teamwork and a spirit of exploration.

F1 Race Car Building

The F1 Race Car Building is a collaborative, hands-on activity that blends creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork—without the need for specialized skills or risks.

Students work together to design and construct their own model race cars, ensuring every component functions seamlessly. The activity culminates in an exciting F1-style race, where students experience the excitement of competition while learning the value of collaboration and strategy.

This activity goes beyond building cars; it nurtures innovation, critical thinking, and communication skills, while fostering a strong sense of achievement. By bringing their ideas to life on the track, students gain confidence in their abilities and a deeper understanding of how teamwork can turn vision into reality.







Tea Culture Experience

This activity immerses students in the charm of tea culture. They will visit a tea exhibition hall to learn about the origin, development, and spread of tea, appreciating its profound heritage through exhibits and guided explanations. Next, they will tour a tea production line, observing tea masters at work and learning traditional tea-making techniques. Professional guides will introduce the history, varieties, growing conditions, and harvesting standards of tea. Under the guidance of tea farmers, students will enter the tea plantation (seasonal) to practice tea-picking techniques and understand harvesting criteria. During the activity, students will taste freshly made Biluochun tea, learn tea-tasting etiquette, and try brewing tea themselves, experiencing the joy of tea art.

Through a combination of knowledge and hands-on practice, students will gain a comprehensive understanding of tea cultivation, harvesting, and production, while deepening their appreciation for traditional tea culture. This activity not only educates but also inspires students to cherish and carry forward traditional cultural heritage.









Raft Building

The Raft Building is a hands-on Project-Based Learning (PBL) experience that encourages students to apply their knowledge of physics while fostering teamwork and problem-solving skills.

Students are tasked with designing and constructing a raft using basic materials, applying key principles such as buoyancy, stability, and force distribution. The activity challenges them to test their designs, identify flaws, and make improvements, emphasizing the importance of trial and error. Working in teams, students collaborate to solve problems, communicate effectively, and learn from failures, ultimately gaining a deeper understanding of the value of perseverance. This project not only enhances students' creativity and critical thinking but also teaches them the importance of teamwork in overcoming obstacles, making it a valuable educational experience.










Garden Expo Park Geo-caching

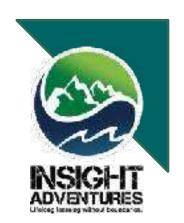

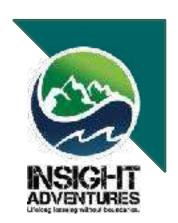
