

## CISB Scholarships and Bobcat Grants

CISB offers up to **RMB 3,000,000** in financial support for our **Scholarships** and **Bobcat Grants**. Students who are awarded scholarships and Bobcat Grants will receive credit on their tuition fees. The scholarships and bursaries are applicable only towards the recipient's tuition at CISB for the stated academic year.

The CISB Scholarships are internal awards, given to current students at CISB. These scholarships recognize students for showcasing excellence in their academics, leadership and growth as well as embodying the values of CISB and attributes of an IB Learner. All Scholarships require a formal application to the CISB Scholarship Committee, accompanied with the required documentation listed for each Scholarship. The CISB Scholarship Committee consists of:

*Please note:* The decisions of the CISB Scholarship Committee are final and binding and are not subject to appeal. Students may apply for multiple scholarships.

### 1. CISB Academic Scholarships

#### **IB Diploma / Canadian HS Diploma students - 200,000RMB**

Scholarships for outstanding academic performance, open to ALL Grade 11 and 12 High School students who meet the criteria.

#### **Grade 9-10 HS students - 100,000RMB**

Scholarships for outstanding academic performance for High School students from Grades 9-10 who meet the criteria.

### 2. CISB Excellence Scholarships

CISB Excellence scholarships recognize and support a broad range of High School student achievements in three key areas, **Leadership**, **STEM** and **the Arts**.

### 3. Bobcat Grants

CISB will also consider applications for financial assistance for our Bobcats team members to qualifying students. This ranges from 1000RMB to a maximum of 5000RMB per student per sporting event. An application should be submitted to the CISB Scholarship Committee via the Head of School in advance of the sporting event along with any requested evidence of financial income and the need for financial support.

## **CISB Student Eligibility Criteria for All Scholarships and Bobcat Grants**

**The student must meet the following requirements:**

- Hold a foreign passport or ID
- Maintain a high academic standing throughout their studies
- Have an exemplary behavior record and with no instances of academic misconduct
- Consistently demonstrate a positive attitude and maximum effort in their learning
- Fully participate in the school program, including field trips, extracurricular activities, etc.
- Meet CISB's attendance requirements as per the CISB Promotion Policy and not have excessive tardies
- Parents or guardians are expected to actively contribute to the school community in a positive manner
- Fulfill any criteria specified for the relevant scholarship

**For CISB students applying for scholarship:**

- Complete Re-Enrollment Application by **May 31<sup>st</sup>**.

Gr 9-10 Scholarships	100,000 RMB (x 3 max)	Eligible to all students from Gr 9-10 who meet the criteria.

Eligibility	<p><b>Diploma Scholarships</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enrolled or prospective students entering Grades 11-12 for the 2026-2027 school year</li> <li>Students with high English proficiency based on internal assessment</li> <li>Students who demonstrate high academic achievement</li> <li>Students who are well-rounded with active participation in co-curricular activities including sports, clubs, art, music, competitions, and who demonstrates leadership qualities</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Gr 9-10 Scholarships</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enrolled or prospective students entering Grades 9-10 for the 2026-2027 school year</li> <li>Students who demonstrate high academic achievement</li> <li>Students with high English proficiency based on internal assessment</li> <li>Students who are well-rounded with active participation in co-curricular activities including sports, clubs, art, music, competitions, and who demonstrates leadership qualities</li> </ul>

<p><b>Revoking of Scholarship</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Should the school determine that false statements or documents were in application, the schools reserves the right to revoke the scholarship.</li> <li>•Should the recipient fail to meet the required expectations of the scholarship award or noticeably falls behind, producing work that is well below his or her capability.</li> <li>•Should recipients fail to be role models for their peers.</li> <li>•At least one formal warning in writing will be given to the student and the parents prior to the withdrawal of the scholarship.</li> <li>•In the case of extreme disciplinary measures, the scholarship may be revoked without any prior written notification.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Deferring Scholarship</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•The scholarship is non-transferable, and the term of study cannot be deferred. <b>Should a student withdraw during their scholarship year(s), 100% tuition will be owed to the school.</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Clarifications</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each student can be awarded only <b><u>ONE</u></b> CISB Scholarship.</li> <li>• The full tuition fees must be paid first.</li> <li>• The scholarship will then be credited to the payee’s bank account after the scholarship decision have been made</li> <li>• The scholarship credit cannot exceed the amount of fees paid by the parent to CISB</li> </ul>

Scholarship	For Internal use only	Qualifying
Leadership Scholarships	80,000 RMB (x 2 max)	<p><b>Criteria:</b> Be in one or more active student leadership roles – for example, House leadership, sports/activities team captain, Student Council, DoE, ASAs etc.</p> <p><b>Application:</b> Personal statement/essay entry or video presentation about their candidacy and demonstrate effectiveness of their leadership.</p> <p>Applications must be supported by 2 teacher statements with contact details for follow-up conversations.</p>
STEM Scholarships	80,000 RMB (x 2 max)	<p><b>Criteria:</b> An outstanding STEM student who has demonstrated excellence and commitment to one or more STEM subject.</p> <p><b>Application:</b> Personal statement/essay entry or video presentation about their candidacy to demonstrate evidence of academic excellence in more than one STEM related discipline, going above and beyond the classroom requirements through STEM competitions – Girls in STEM, robotics, internships, summer camps, competitions.</p> <p>Applications must be supported by 2 teacher statements with contact details for follow-up conversations.</p>
Arts Scholarships	80,000 RMB (x 2 max)	<p><b>Criteria:</b> An outstanding Arts student who has demonstrated excellence and commitment to one or more Arts subject.</p> <p><b>Application:</b> Personal statement/essay entry or video presentation about their candidacy to demonstrate evidence of passion or excellence in at least one Arts discipline, that celebrates their excellence to a wider audience in a way that celebrates and promotes the artist and the school.</p> <p>Applications must be supported by 2 teacher statements with contact details for follow-up conversations.</p>

Gr 9 – 12 students	5000 RMB (x 10 max)	<p>Criteria: Awarded for members of sports teams and activities to attend official events /tournaments outside of Beijing to families that are financially unable to support their child attending such events.</p> <p><b><u>Eligibility</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The applicant must submit evidence of their financial situation.</li> <li>2. Each Bobcat Grant applicant must be recognised by their coaches as demonstrating the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Full participation in training</i></li> <li>• <i>Being a sportsperson/team player</i></li> <li>• <i>Commitment and valuable performances</i></li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p>The application must be accompanied by a supporting statement signed by the Athletics Director and the relevant Sports Coach to support the 3 criteria above.</p> <p><b><u>Application</u></b></p> <p>The Bobcat Grants will be awarded by application by students. The more information is submitted to support the application, the more likely the Bobcat Grant is to be awarded. As well as a document from their Sports Coach and the Athletics Director, applications could also include a personal statement, an essay or a video presentation.</p>
